
Immersion

Modern Language – Arabic – Includes ANTH 275 Global Islam or ANTH 365 Culture & Politics in ME, which fulfills your Islamic Culture requirement

Economics – ECON 101 Microeconomics does not count in the Immersion, but is a prerequisite and is the Global Perspective

Psychology – PSYC 101 Intro to Psychology does not count in the Immersion, but is a prerequisite and is a Social/Scientific Principles Perspective





CO-OP

"Co-op" = Cooperative Education

Opportunity to gain meaningful work experience before graduation Full-time, paid employment directly related to your field of study

Prerequisite – 3rd Year Standing Must first complete SCBI 035 Careers in Business 1 or 2 Summers = 16 weeks

Must be in Good Standing (at least 2.0 GPA)
