- Possess a GPA of 3.5/4.0 or higher and an IELTS score of 6.5 or equivalent in TOEFL. Applicants with a GPA of 3.0-3.5 may be considered if they have exceptional industrial experience.
- Demonstrate excellent communication and presentation skills.
- Preferably have experience in conducting machine shop or machine tool operations training.
- Previous teaching or tutoring experience is advantageous.
 These requirements ensure that candidates have the necessary qualifications and skills to excel in this role.

 - Three recommendation letters, signed by the recommenders and including their email addresses or phone numbers
- 3. Applications will be reviewed on an ongoing basis until suitable candidates are selected. Only shortlisted candidates will be contacted.
