## A Message from Vice Provost Christine Licata

After a comprehensive vendor search and in-depth consultations with peer schools, I am delighted to share the news with you that the industry-leading curriculum management system, [CourseLeaf](#), has been chosen to help transform our curriculum lifecycle management processes at RIT.

CourseLeaf is an academic operations platform, developed by Leapfrog Technologies, which is currently used at more than 500 higher education institutions around the world.

The CourseLeaf implementation at RIT will occur in two phases over the next two to three years:

### **Phase I: Bulletins and Course Catalogs**

#### **Overview:**

- Manage workflows for the annual publication of RIT's bulletins and course catalogs
- Integrate with SIS and the Programs of Study website to provide program overviews and curriculum

#### **Target Implementation Timeline:**

- Development and testing during AY 2024-2025
- First PDF bulletins and course catalogs will be published in late summer 2025
- Searchable online catalog will go live in late summer 2025

### **Phase II: Curriculum Management**

#### **Overview:**

- Manage workflows for the development of new courses and programs, and modifications to existing courses and programs
- Strengthen foundational administrative practices for curriculum management

- Enhance the efficiency, accuracy, and integration of curriculum systems across multiple platforms at RIT

### **Target Implementation Timeline:**

- Curricular workflows will be documented in early spring 2025
- Development and testing during AY 2025-2026
- Launch date TBD
