

# Short-Term Study Abroad Programs

One of four types of study abroad programs, short-term faculty-led programs are designed and developed by RIT faculty members, who lead a group of students on a short-term program abroad. The location, duration and course offerings depend on the expertise of the faculty member. Costs include RIT tuition, a program fee and out-of-pocket expenses.



**63% of RIT students who studied abroad last year went on short term faculty-led programs and have done things like:**

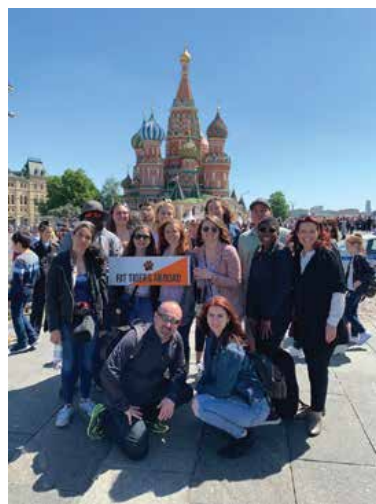
- Explored sustainable engineering practices in Ireland.
- Visited gaming studios in Japan.
- Assisted with a faculty research project in the Mayalasian Rainforest.
- Learned about sustainable city initiatives in Sweden.
- Toured automotive manufacturing facilities in Germany.
- Created an interactive art installation in Paris.
