A) Airfare quote is for a round trip ticket from Rochester, NY

B) housing cost is based on average rent of 350.00 Euros per month

C) For RIT processing, graduate school applications and job applications, students may need to request a WES credential evaluation which translates your overseas transcript to U.S. terms. For more information visit: wes.org.

D) Cost is for German health insurance, estimated at 120 Euros per month. It is mandatory for students to be covered by medical insurance while in country. Students may be able to opt out of purchasing German health insurance by showing proof of coverage under RIT's emergency medical insurance provider On Call International.

E) One-time payment of semester fee of 156 Euros for Wurzburg campus. The semester fee for Schweinfurt campus is 109.50 Euros. This fee includes the semester ticket, which entitles students to free use of the transport system in the city of residence.
