Also, students are still required to pay RIT health and activity fees while they are studying abroad. Prices are subject to change. When you confirm your participation in this program, you will sign a contract in the compass that outlines the payment process and cancellation policies. Please read this carefully.

Cancellation note: Please be aware of and understand the program cancellation policy. Cancellation fees may apply if you decide to cancel your program after being accepted and confirming your participation.

A) Round trip airfare from Rochester, NY to Kansai International Airport (Osaka, Japan)

B) Cost shown is for a non-reserved ticket on the JR Haruka Limited Express. Cost for a reserved seat is \$32.00.

C) Cost for Dorm Kamogawa (men's dormitory). Residents must pay additional fee of \$81.32 per month for gas/electricity. Dormitory housing cost plus Communal charge is 29,100 yen, or \$213.26 per month. Gas/electricity and internet fees for Dorm Kamogawa are 7,000 yen per month/\$52.32 per month USD.

D) Housing entrance fee - non-refundable fee of 13,000 yen (\$95.32) for room clean-up after departure

E) Estimate for meals is approximately 45,000 yen per month, or \$329.94 USD per month.

F) Local transportation estimated to be 10,000 yen per month, or \$73.32 per month USD.

G) Cost for a multi-entry student visa.
