- A)** Round trip airfare from Rochester to Copenhagen, Denmark
- B)** Cost shown is rent and utilities for double accommodation at University Housing. Housing cost is estimated at 4300 SEK per month (approximately \$398.24 USD per month)
- C)** Estimated cost of food, calculated at 2000 SEK per month (\$185.23 USD per month).
- D)** Cost shown is estimated cost for telephone and Internet (approximately \$27.78 per month.)
- E)** Cost for public transportation is estimated at \$50.94 per month (550 SEK)
- F)** For RIT processing, graduate school applications and job applications, students may need to request a WES credential evaluation which translates your overseas transcript to U.S. terms. For more information visit: wes.org.
- G)** International exchange students studying in Sweden are covered by insurance 24 hours a day while in Sweden. The personal injury insurance covers students while on the university's premises. There is a deductible of 1,500 Krona, or approximately \$172.00 USD for damage or loss of personal property claims.
