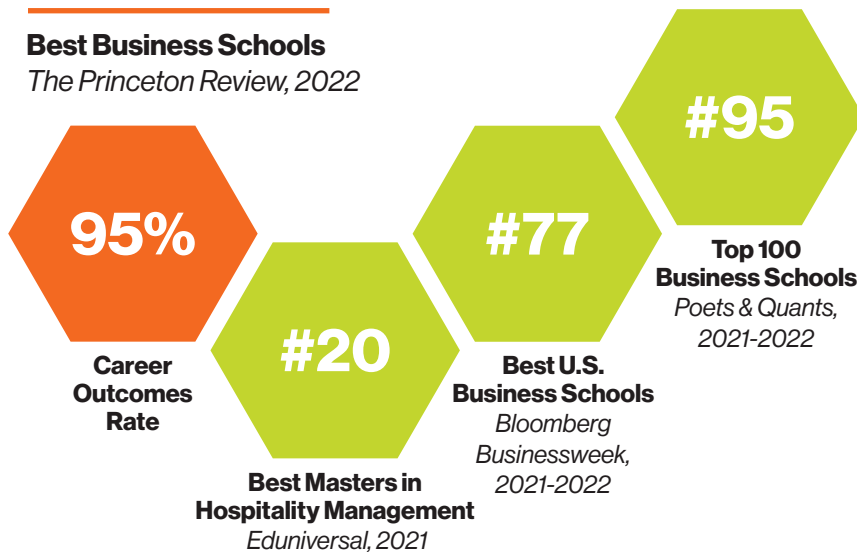
National and International Work
