1. Login to the [MyDSO student portal](#) and select “My eligibility” from the left side menu (circled in red).

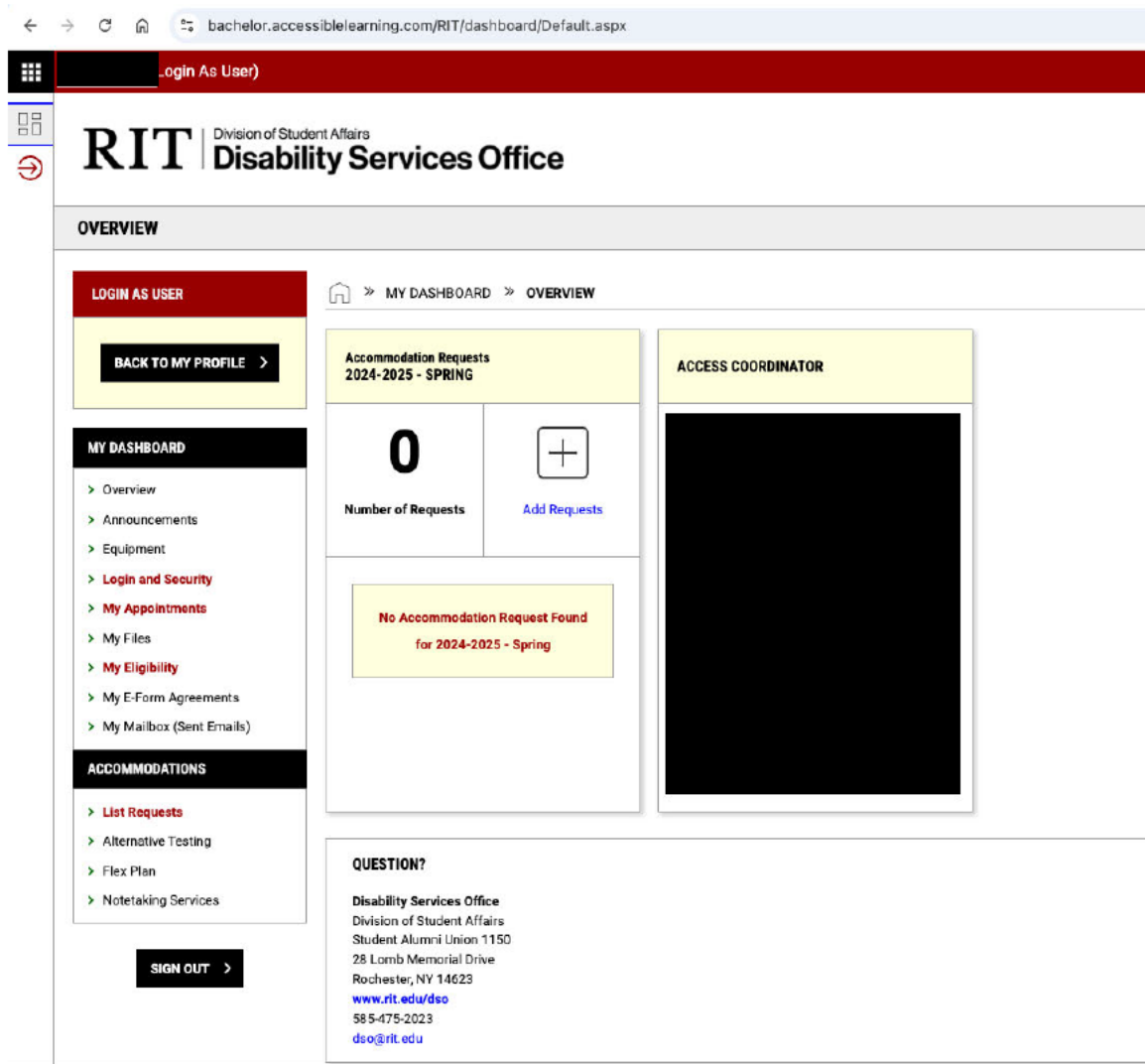
