

CO-OP

"Co-op" = Cooperative Education

Opportunity to gain meaningful work experience before graduation

Full-time, paid employment directly related to your field of study

Prerequisite – 3rd Year Standing

Must first complete SCBI 035 Careers in Business

1 or 2 Summers = 16 weeks

Must be in Good Standing (at least 2.0 GPA)
