

University Survey Committee Review Process For Surveys In Scope

Scope Outline

Institutional current student, faculty or staff survey efforts that span across multiple units or colleges are advised to go through the University Survey Committee review process. Examples include:

- Surveys that are administered to an entire body of students, staff or faculty
- Surveys that are administered to entire subpopulations based on year level, gender, ethnicity, etc.
- Surveys that are administered across multiple units or colleges
- Surveys that have a broad purpose or used for institutional improvement
- Surveys that are to be administered to 2,000 individuals or more

If you are not sure whether your survey should go through the committee review, please check with the University Survey Committee members. The need for a review will be made on a case-by-case basis.
