SUPPORT COMMUNICATION EDUCATION

Over 90% of deaf and hard-of-hearing children are born to hearing families who initially are unable to communicate with their child. TRIPOD, a non-profit organization headquartered in Burbank, California was established in 1982 to assist families. TRIPOD provides deaf and hard-of-hearing children learning opportunities in a full inclusion school setting, as well as information and emotional support for their families.

As soon as parents learn of their baby's hearing loss, the Montessori Parent-Infant/Toddler Program opens avenues of communication in the spirit of support, discovery and understanding so that parenting can resume. A rich learning environment, encouraging self-reliance and active inquiry is offered in the Montessori Preschool/Kindergarten Program.

From the first through eighth grades, TRIPOD students and their hearing peers learn side by side; teachers and students communicate freely, demonstrating that deafness need not be a barrier. In the full inclusion Elementary and Middle School Programs-TRIPOD students are achieving at academic levels above the national norms for deaf and hard-of-hearing children. This unique partnership and co-enrollment of students with Burbank Unified School District will expand to the high school level (freshman class) in the Fall of 1994.

TRIPOD has received national and international recognition from parents, professionals and the deaf community with 3 California school districts implementing the model. Implementation is also being considered by programs in North Carolina, Texas and Colorado. In addition, TRIPOD's national toll-free hotline, the GRAPEVINE, provides up-to-date information on all aspects of childhood deafness, enabling parents and professionals to make informed decisions.
