No previous Italian language required. Must be fluent in ASL.

Access Services

VR Support

Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) services may provide financial assistance to NTID students studying abroad. Ask your VR counselor to determine if assistance is available.

Funding

Financial aid may apply towards some program costs (if you take between 6-12 credits abroad). Study abroad scholarships are also available through RIT Education Abroad, NTID and national scholarships.
