DIS - Study Abroad in Scandinavia

Copenhagen, Denmark
Fall, Spring, Summer

Denmark is known globally for innovative thinking and high quality medical research and is home to the Medicon Valley, a comprehensive life science cluster that attracts many successful companies to the region. In addition to classroom based learning and research, students on DIS programs also participate in site visits and meet with experts in the field through program study tours.

Summer Psychology in Croatia

Zagreb, Croatia
Summer

Earn 6 credits towards an immersion in Psychology while studying for 5 weeks in Central Europe. Gain an understanding of the cultural influences of modern psychology while studying and living in Croatia's capital city of Zagreb and participate in a week-long study tour to Vienna, Austria and Munich, Germany to visit important sites related to psychology history.

No language requirements. Courses taught in English.

When You Should Go

Work closely with your academic advisor to determine the timing that will work best for your program of study.

Tips

Consider taking immersion, free electives or general education courses abroad for more flexibility in program options.

A shorter summer program may be a good option to fit in an international experience for Health Sciences majors.
